## Why CETMONS

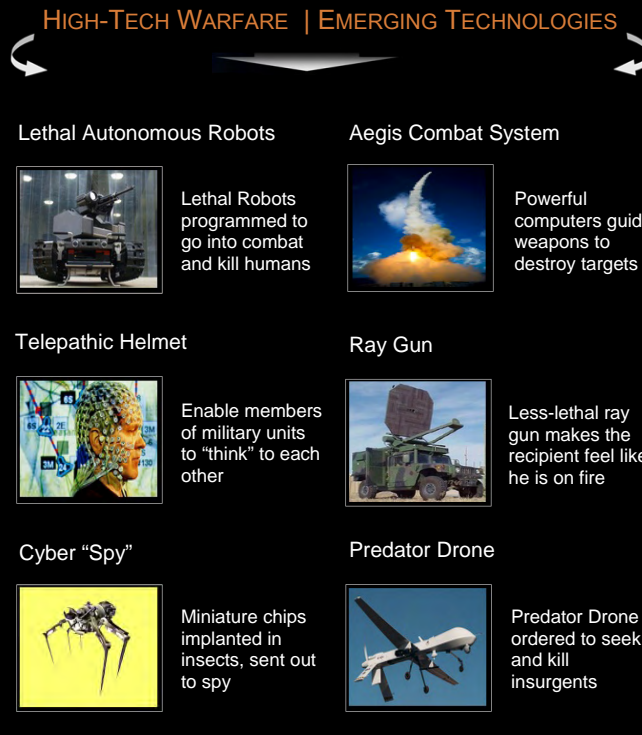
### Technology developed for military purposes


