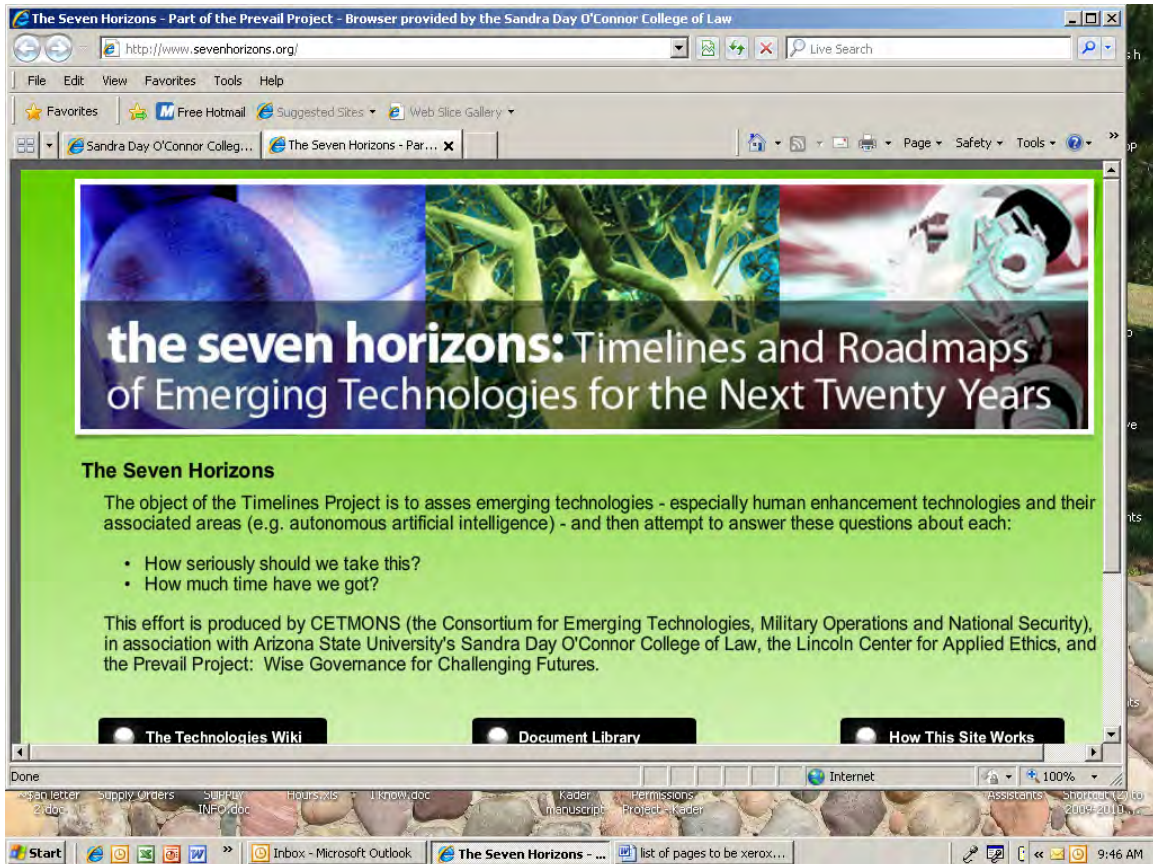


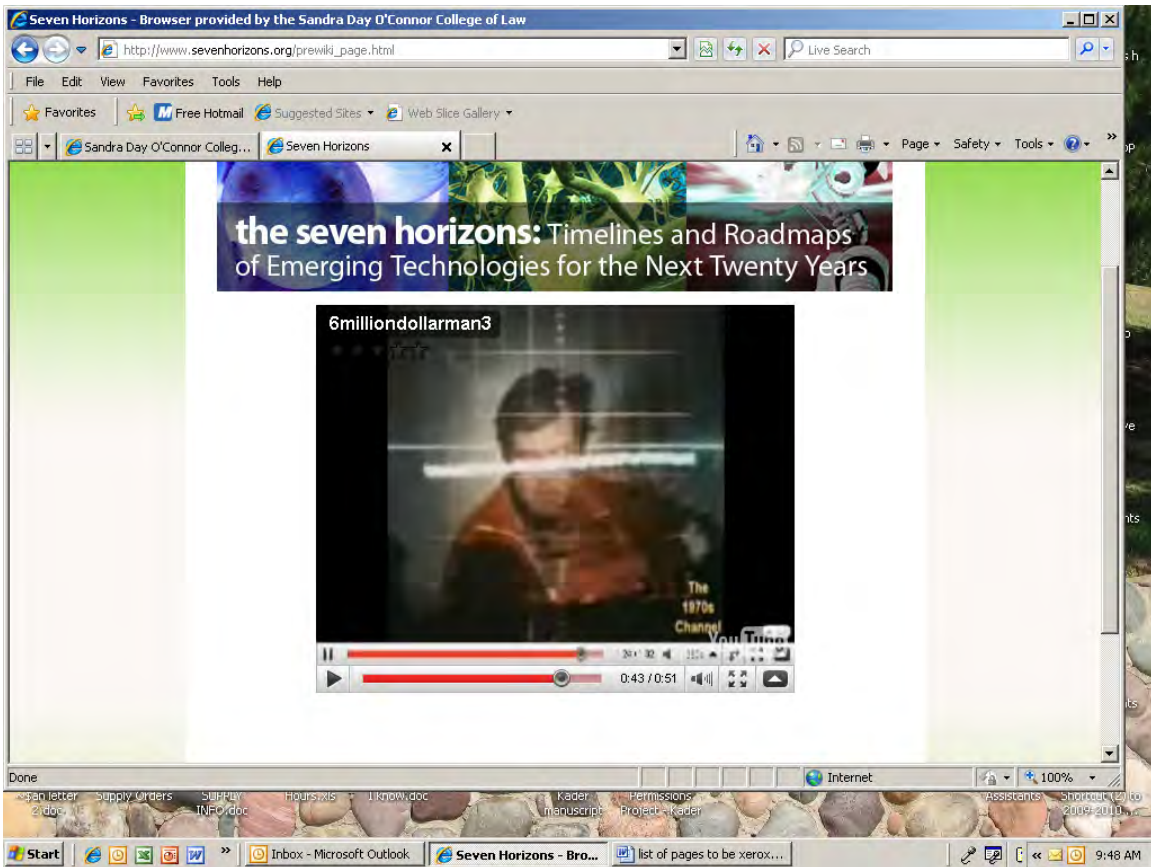
Instructions for the Wiki at the website: www.sevenhorizons.org

Start at the Seven Horizons Home Page:



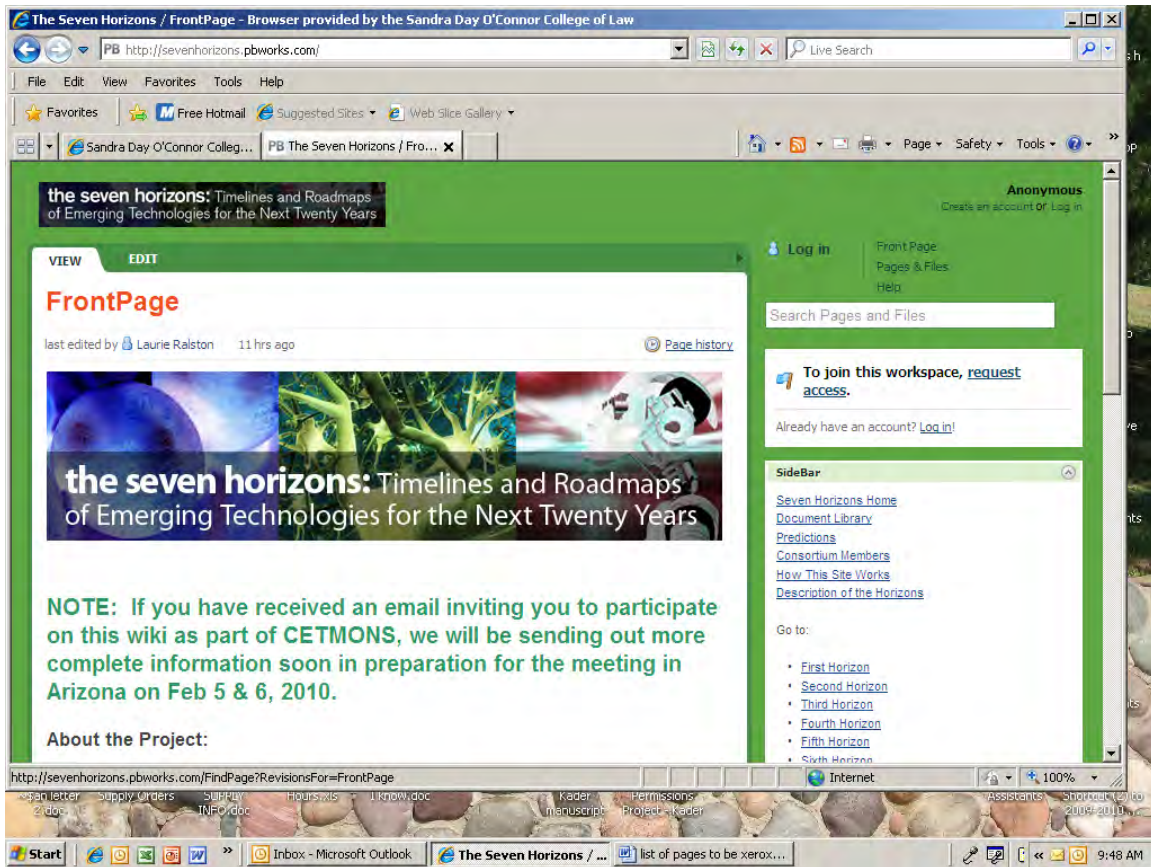

If you hit the “The Technologies Wiki” button, it will take you to The Video introduction page:



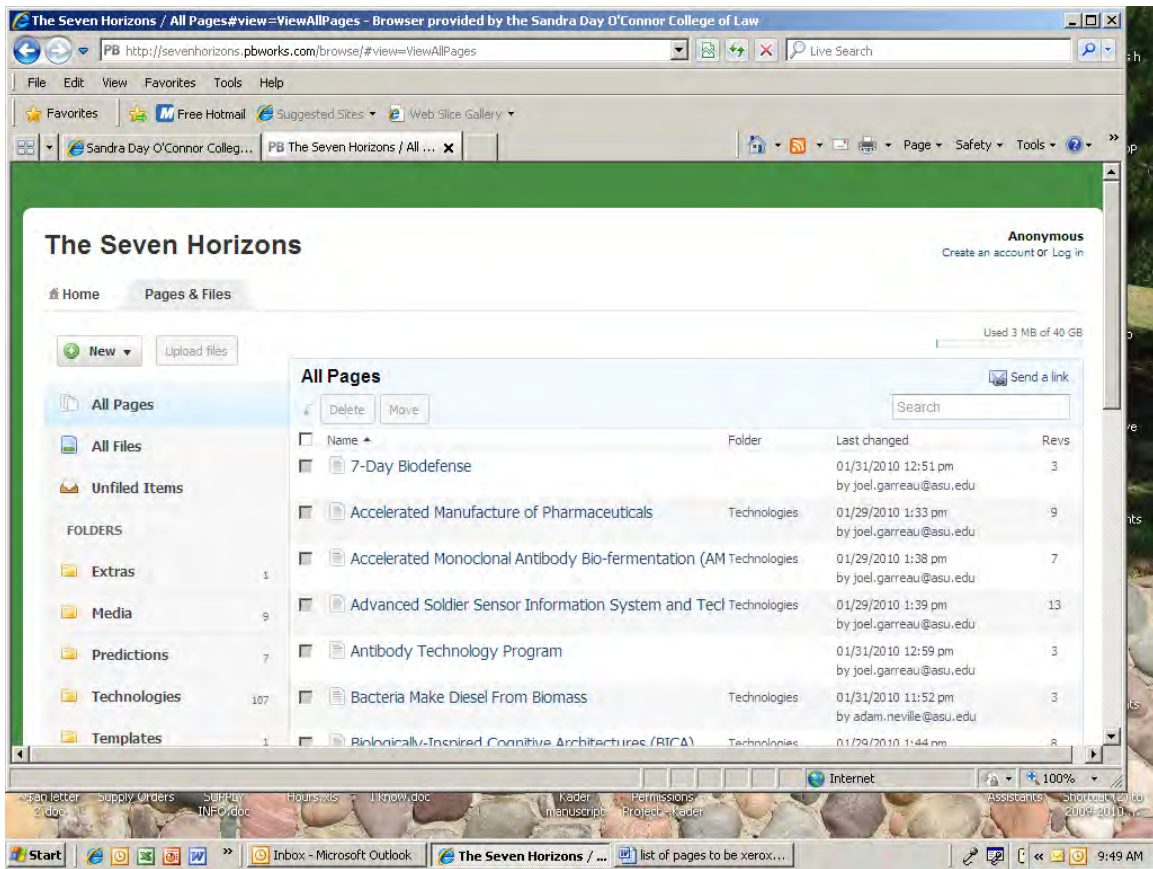

Which takes you to the Wiki front page:



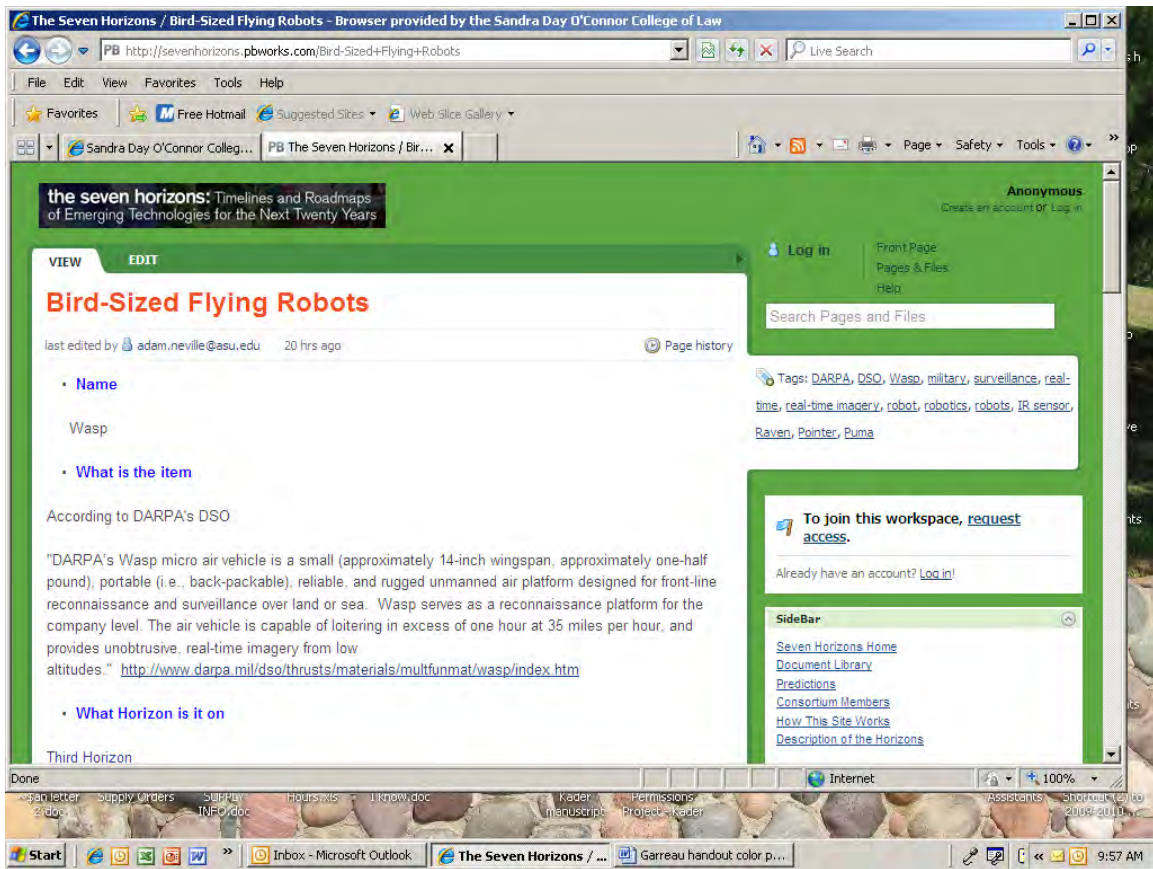

From which you can pick a subject such as “Bird-Sized Flying Robots”



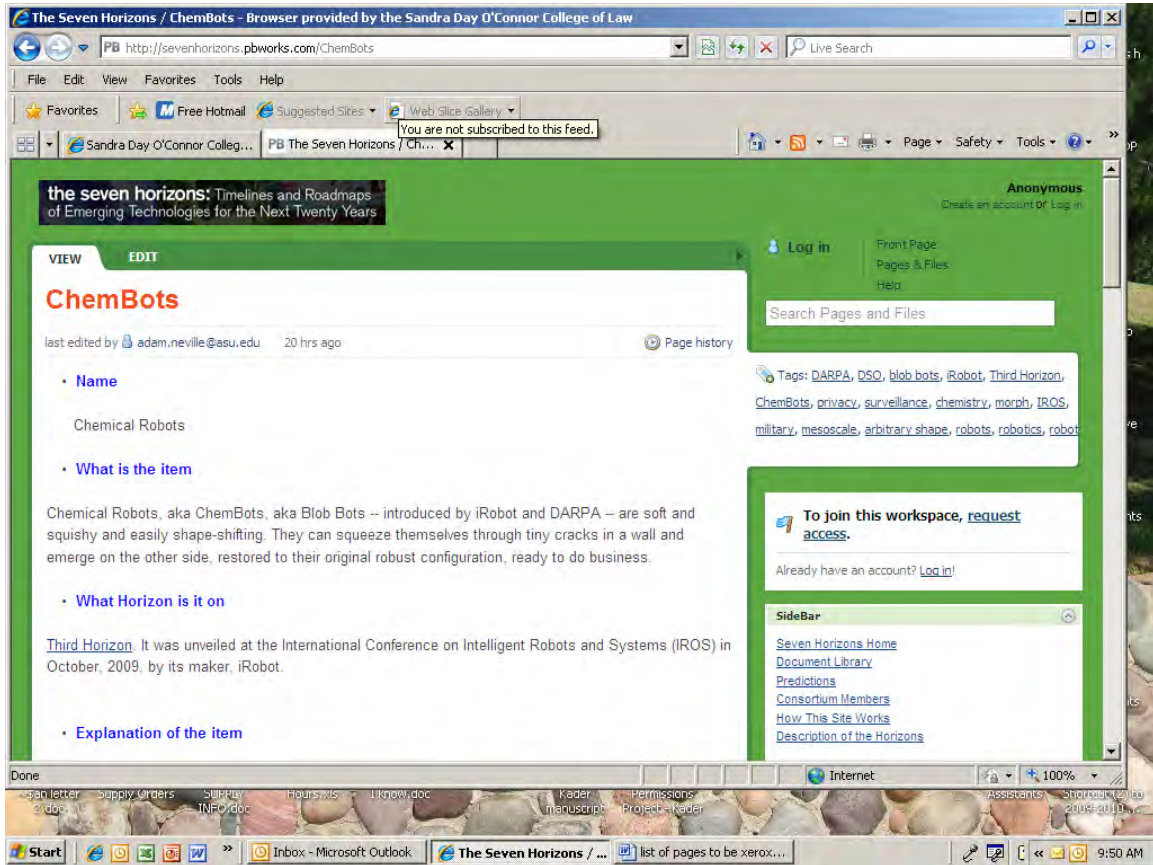

At which you can, for example, link to roadmaps such as “Unmanned Systems Integrated Roadmap”:



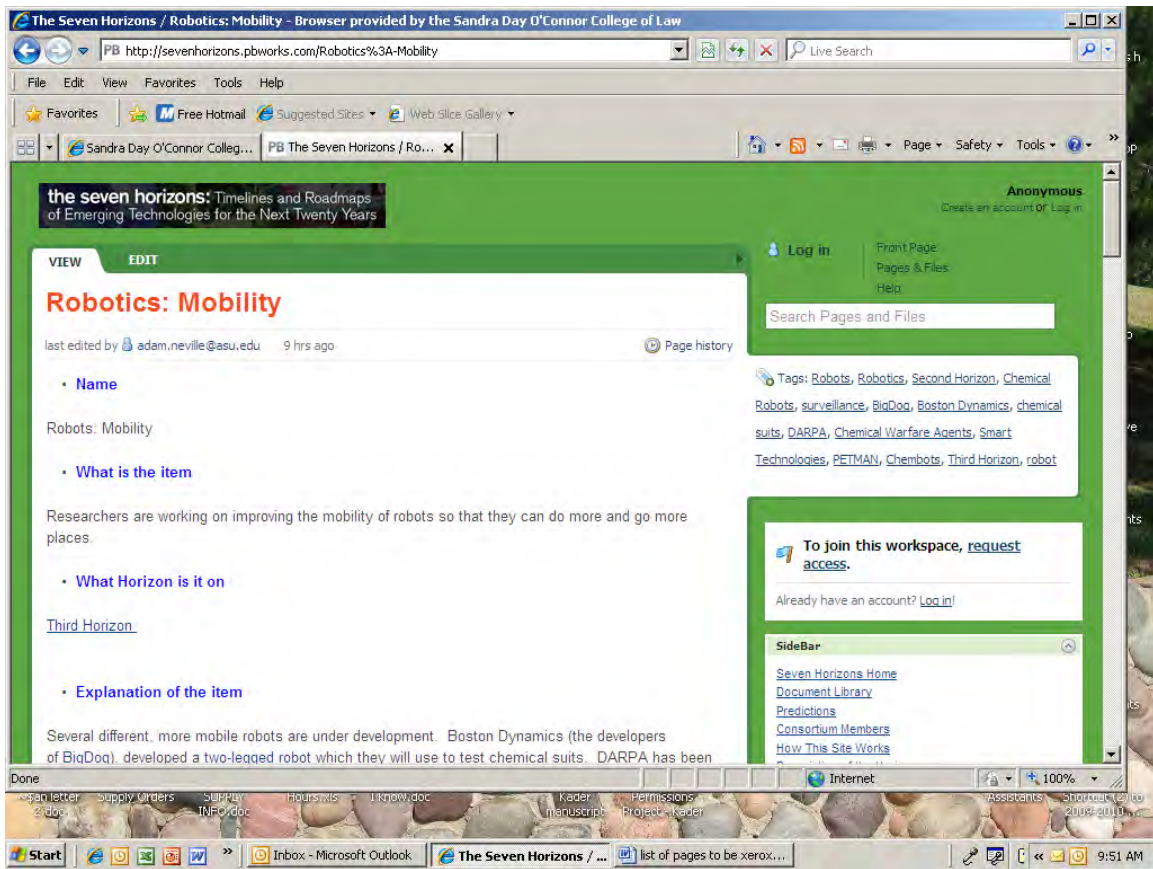

And from there you can link to the larger, meta subject, “Robotics: Mobility”



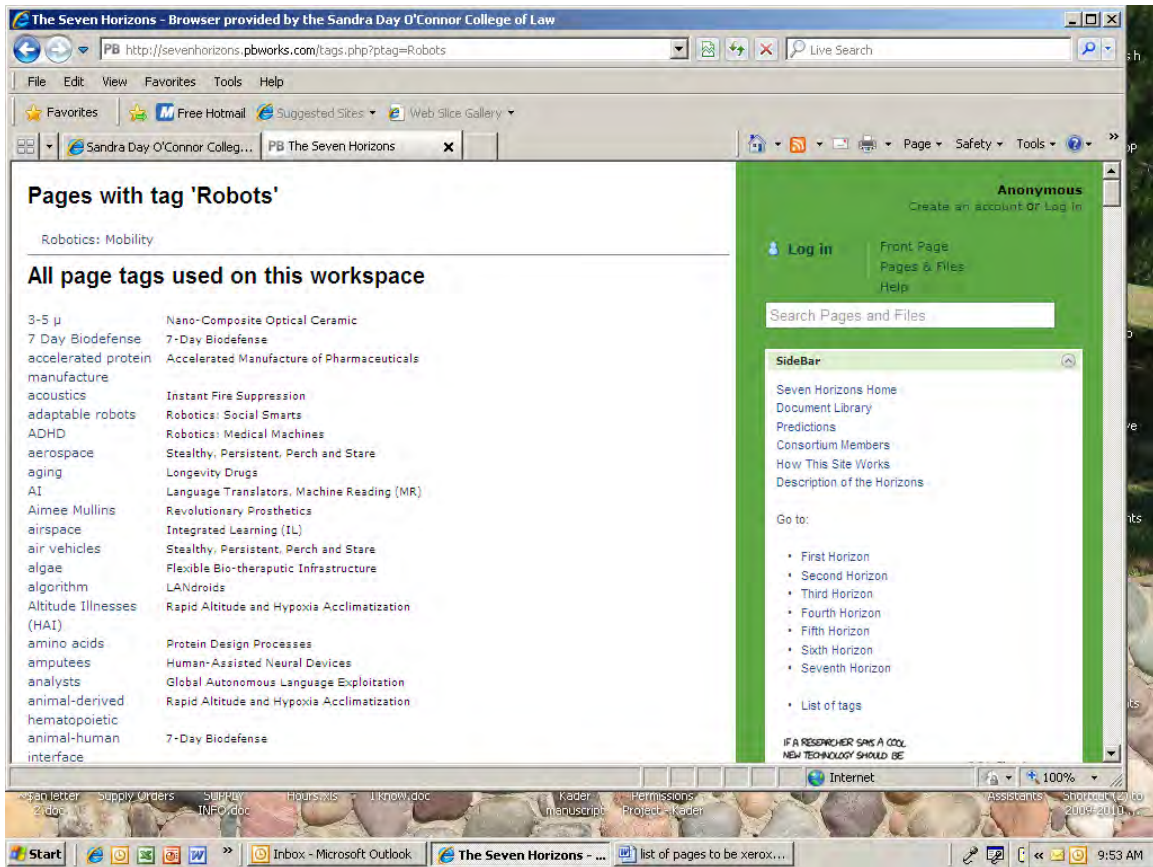

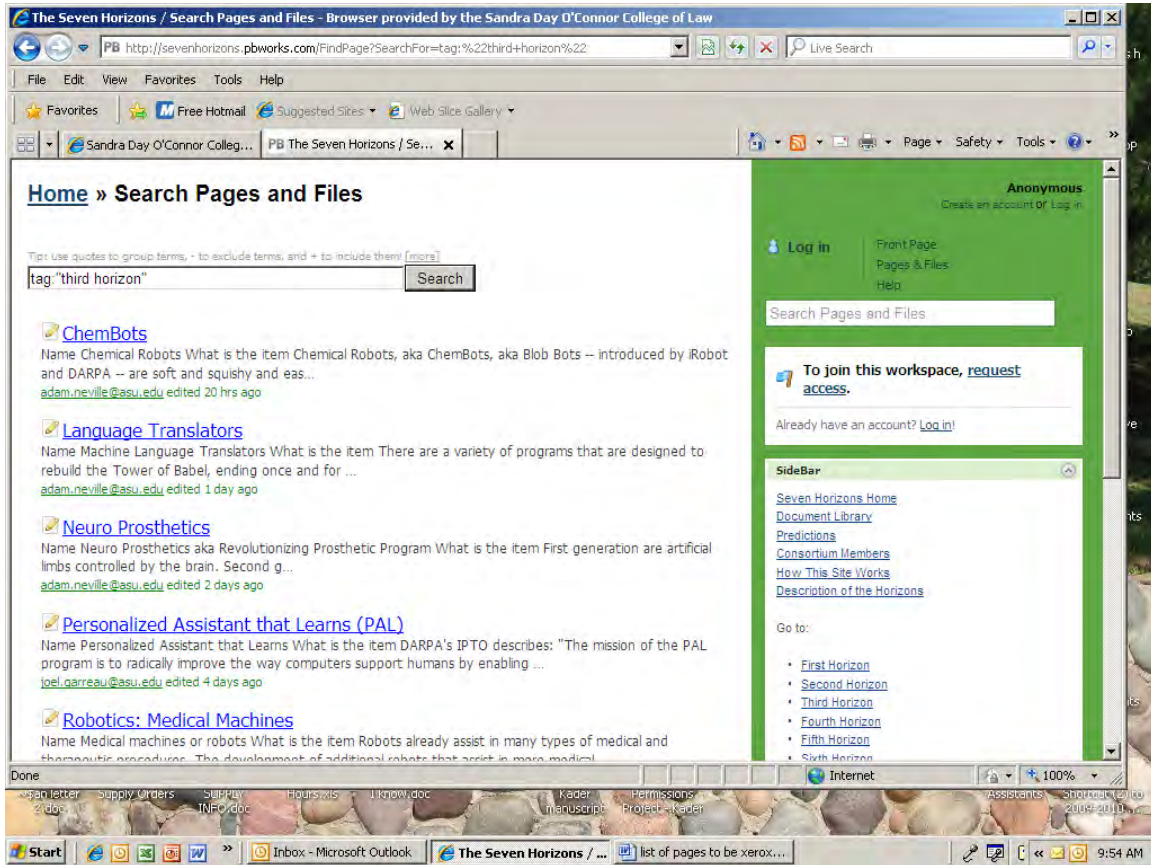

You can also link to the list of related items by tag lines. Click on “robots” for example, or type it into the search window, and you get the list of related subjects:

If, instead of seeing items related by subject matter, you wish to see items that are related by being similarly close to commercial eruption, you can click on “Third Horizon,” for example, or any other horizon. On “Third Horizon” you will see the list of items that are thought all to be in the “Venture Capitalist” stage, approximately two to six years to reaching the public, absent some deal-killer emerging.
